

## Organization

Sassari's ERSU (Regional Agency for the Right to Higher Education) aims to promote, provide and coordinate various forms of assistance to groups and individuals in favor of university students in the arena of rights to higher education in accordance with law n. 37 of 1987/9/14.

The Agency pursues its institutional objectives in harmony with the region's general position on rights to higher education and in collaboration with the University.

The Regional Agency for the right to Higher Education's Board of Directors is appointed through a decree by the President of the Regional Committee following deliberation by said committee, in accordance with law n. 20 of 1995/8/23. The Board of Directors is comprised of the President, two regional representatives, a university representative elected by the faculty, and a student representative elected by the students themselves. The Board of Directors outlines the agency's goals and programs and verifies that administrative outcomes match the delineated objectives.

The **President** of the organization is the Agency's legal representative and is appointed by the President of the Region. He or she presides over the Board of Directors and oversees the implementation of decisions.

The **Board of Auditors** examines the legitimacy of the Agency's decisions from an administrative and accounting standpoint. It is comprised of three members appointed by the President of the Region.

The **Director** coordinates the management of the Agency through independent organizational and financial controls. The Director is appointed by the President of the Region.

## The right to higher education

Protection of the right to higher education encompasses all those acts and initiatives implemented in order to facilitate access to higher education by deserving students, even those who would not otherwise have the necessary financial means to do so. This is based on principles outlined in the Italian Constitution (articles 3 and 34) and later detailed in law n. 390 of 1991, DPCM of 2001, and regional law n. 37 of 1987.

Sassari's ERSU (Regional Agency for the Right to Higher Education) was founded through a regional law. It oversees the implementation of initiatives protecting the right to higher education of students registered at the University of Sassari, the Music Conservatory (*Conservatorio di Musica*) and the Academy of Fine Arts (*Accademia delle Belle Arti*).

ERSU's activities include both programs involving the whole student body and specific initiatives benefiting competent students with financial difficulties, who are awarded scholarships and other forms of aid through a selection process (*concorso*).

Scholarships are the ultimate form of financial aid. In the 2008/2009 academic year, 2.383 scholarships were awarded for a total of € 6.339.223, 00. A single scholarship can amount to a minimum of € 1.290.00 to a maximum of € 3.338.00. A portion is paid out in cash, while the remainder is used to cover services (room and board). Scholarship winners and qualified students (second year and beyond) are entitled to two meals per day (resident students) or one meal per day (local students and commuters).

Students from out of town may stay in the university's housing facilities or receive financial aid for living expenses.

ERSU provides accommodations for 544 students in its residence halls and in city apartments. Beginning in the 2007/2008 academic year, students from out of town without scholarships who meet the academic and financial requirements have also had the option of competing for housing expense funds.

Additional services that may be accessed through a selection process (*concorso*) are: funding for international travel, funding for research/ theses on international cooperation, funding for individual educational travel, and aid for students with special financial needs.

Some noteworthy services available to the whole student body include: cafeteria services, funding for cultural activities and educational travel, and discounts for transportation expenses and sports activities.

### **Services offered through a selection process (*concorso*)**

These services do not cater to the whole student body, but rather aim to allow economically disadvantaged but academically deserving students to reach the highest level of education possible.

The criteria and conditions of each selection process are published yearly on the Agency's website, found at [www.ersusassari.it](http://www.ersusassari.it).

### **Scholarships**

Scholarships are the main form of aid dispensed by Ersu. Aid is given out in the form of money and services such as room and board.

Scholarships are awarded via a public selection process (*concorso*) and are available to economically disadvantaged but academically deserving students as defined by the yearly selection announcement and according to the guidelines of the Decree of the Prime Minister's Council (2001/4/9).

Qualified students are exempt from university and Ersu taxes.

The selection process is open to students officially registered at the University of Sassari, Academy of Fine Arts, or the Conservatory in the following degree programs: *laurea* (undergraduate degree), *laurea specialistica* (specialized undergraduate degree), *dottorato di ricerca* (research doctorate), and *scuole di specializzazione* (*specialization programs*).

The announcement of the selection process for scholarships is posted before the start of the academic year, in July-August. In order to participate, students must fill out an online application on the Agency's website ([www.ersusassari.it](http://www.ersusassari.it)) and subsequently provide hard copies of required documentation and a signed application form to the *Settore Diritto allo studio* (Right to education Department). ### **Aid for housing expenses**

Aid for housing expenses has been made possible thanks to regional funding beginning in the 2007/2008 academic year. Students are provided with funds that cut down their housing expenses.

This type of aid can be obtained through a public selection process by students who meet the required academic and financial eligibility criteria and who are not benefiting from scholarships or free board during the same academic year.

In order to request aid for housing expenses, students must have an officially registered rental contract (minimum duration of ten months) valid for the current academic year. Students may renew their aid for the official duration of their course of study.

Students eligible to participate in the selection process are those from out of town, born or residing in Sardinia, registered in *laurea*, *laurea magistrale*, *laurea specialistica a ciclo unico* and *specialistica biennale* degree programs at the University of Sassari, the Academy of Fine Arts, or the Conservatory.

The announcement for the housing aid selection process is published in December. Students may apply online through the Agency's website, [www.ersusassari.it](http://www.ersusassari.it) and subsequently provide hard copies of required documentation and a signed application form to the *Settore Diritto allo studio* (Right to education Department). ### **Aid for theses on international cooperation**

Thanks to regional funding, Ersu dispenses scholarships supporting students preparing theses on issues related to international cooperation. This initiative is an implementation of regional law n. 19 of 1996, "Norms concerning cooperation with developing nations and international collaboration".

These scholarships benefit University of Sassari students working towards three-year *Laurea* degrees or *Specialistica* and *Ciclo unico* type degrees.

The ranking which ultimately determines the recipients is based upon an evaluation of the content of the theses as related to the objectives outlined by the law, as well as on academic merit and financial status parameters.

The announcement for thesis aid selection process is published in January on the Agency's website, [www.ersusassari.it](http://www.ersusassari.it). In order to apply, students must fill out all attached forms and hand in their applications at the *Settore Diritto allo studio* (Right to education Department) by the three established deadlines: March 31<sup>st</sup>, June 30<sup>th</sup> and September 30<sup>th</sup>. ### **Aid for educational travel**

Funds are dispensed to students registered at the University of Sassari, Academy of Fine Arts or the Conservatory in an effort to cut down on expenses incurred during educational trips both in Italy and abroad.

Such aid aims to favor students' participation in internships, conferences, scientific inquiries and educational trips, enabling them to optimize their research and theses related efforts.

In order to be eligible for educational travel aid, students must meet the same academic merit and financial status requirements necessary for access to Ersu's housing facilities in the current academic year. Applications may be submitted by March 31<sup>st</sup> of each year. Application forms and information on criteria for the awarding of aid and statement of accounts are available on the [www.ersusassari.it](http://www.ersusassari.it) website.

### **Aid for students with disabilities**

Ersu sets aside a portion of its scholarship and housing funds for students with disabilities. As provided for by law DPCM of 2001/4/9, more lenient cutoffs for academic and financial status requirements are applied to these students.

This initiative is aimed towards students who are at least 66% disabled as outlined by law n. 17 of 1999/1/18.

Interested students can apply online at [www.ersu.sassari.it](http://www.ersu.sassari.it) following the same procedure delineated for scholarships and housing aid; they must additionally provide a certificate substantiating their disability status.

Moreover, these students are exempt from the Ersu tax.

### **International Mobility**

Students receiving scholarships have access to funds for participation in international mobility programs, both within and outside of European Union

sponsored programs provided that such internships or courses of study can be academically recognized and count towards credit in an Italian degree program. Such aid is dispensed for a maximum of ten months. Money provided by European Union funds or other bilateral non EU agreements is deducted from the monthly award.

This form of aid must be requested through an online application for the selection process (*concorso*) for scholarships and housing funds. For details, see procedures for awarding of scholarships and housing funds.

### **Housing Services**

Sassari's Ersu gives students from out of town who meet the academic and financial requirements the opportunity to live in its university residence facilities. Currently, the Agency manages 544 beds in various locations around Sassari and 25 additional beds in the city of Nuoro. A portion of these facilities is reserved for Erasmus students, and another fraction is set aside for disabled students and their escorts.

The "Alessio Fontana" student residence hall in Via Coppino counts 240 beds and is the most modern and functional of Ersu's residential facilities. Its single and double rooms all have bathrooms, air conditioning, refrigerators and internet access.

The "Via Padre Manzella" student residence hall is the oldest student housing facility (inaugurated in 1964). It holds 104 beds and was recently completely renovated and equipped with better amenities and wireless internet access.

The "Via Verona" student residence hall was recently built; it holds 150 beds, has wireless internet access, and also houses a small conference hall and a computer network room.

Admission to university housing is awarded through a selection process (*concorso*) and is open to students meeting the same academic and financial pre-requisites required for access to scholarships.

Applications for selection are open yearly in July-August, just as for scholarships, and students may apply online at [www.ersusassari.it](http://www.ersusassari.it) and subsequently provide hard copies of required documentation and a signed application form to the *Settore Diritto allo studio* (Right to education Department). ### **Extraordinary Circumstance Aid**

Extraordinary circumstance aid is reserved for situations in which a student's dire financial condition threatens to compromise or end his/her capacity to continue with the course of study.

In order to be eligible for this type of aid, students registered at the University of Sassari, Academy of Fine Arts or the Conservatory must meet the outlined requirements and provide documentation proving their extraordinary circumstances of financial need. This special form of aid can only be disbursed once over the student's entire course of study.

Students already receiving scholarships or other funding from Ersu during the same academic year are not eligible to receive extraordinary circumstance aid.

The announcement of the selection process is posted yearly on the Agency's website, [www.ersusassari.it](http://www.ersusassari.it). A signed application form must be delivered to the *Settore Diritto allo studio* (Right to education Department). ### **Further information/ suggestions**

The notices announcing selection procedures (known as *bandi di concorso*) outline the criteria and instructions for applying to receive the described services. Applications must be compiled by the established deadlines and duly signed. Failure to do so shall disqualify the applicant.

Each year, the Agency conducts an investigation of a sample of the self-certified statements made by applicants regarding their academic and financial status. Any student undersigning false information shall incur in administrative sanctions ranging from being permanently banned from receiving any form of aid in the future to being reported to the local judicial authorities.

### **Services available to the entire student body**

These services are open to any student regularly registered at the university for the current academic year.

### **Transportation discounts**

Beginning in 2004, ERSU and Sassari's Public Transportation Department have had an agreement enabling students to receive discounts on monthly and yearly public transportation passes.

Based on its resources, the Agency is able to make a certain number of public transportation passes available to students.

Instructions on how to obtain such discounts and on the timing required are available on the Agency's website, [www.ersusassari.it](http://www.ersusassari.it). In order to request this service, applicants must submit documentation demonstrating their status as students of the University of Sassari, Academy of Fine Arts or the Conservatory along with identification and their *codice fiscale* (tax identification number). ### **Part time employment**

Ersu gives university students paid part-time job opportunities in its offices lasting up to 150 hours in accordance with law 390/91.

The University of Sassari publishes yearly notices of a selection process of applicants and their subsequent rankings.

Ersu then obtains a list of students from the University who are available to work in its offices. It also provides a written contract and insurance coverage.

### **Sports Activities (Ersu- Cus agreement)**

In an attempt to implement decisions established with L.R. 37/38, ERSU encourages students' participation in sports activities through its collaboration with CUS (University Sports Center), which grants free access to the "San Giovanni" sports facilities and offers discounts at the city's sports facilities (where students can participate in swimming, track and field, soccer tournaments, 5 on 5 soccer, basketball, fencing, etc.)

For insurance and identification purposes, in order to access the sports facilities and participate in available activities, students must have CUS cards.

Students from out of town may obtain a medical certificate (declaring they are fit to participate in sports) at the clinic located at the student residence in Via Manzella. ### **Funding for cultural and leisure activities**

ERSU supports educational, social and cultural initiatives furthered by University of Sassari, Academy and Conservatory students.

Requests for funding of such activities can be made by student organizations or university clubs with a minimum of 30 student members.

The Board of Directors decides each year the exact amount of funds set aside for cultural activities.

Applications must be presented by March 31<sup>st</sup> of each year. Application forms, details about the rules, eligibility requirements and statement of accounts can be found on the web at [www.ersusassari.it](http://www.ersusassari.it). Priority will be given to applications demonstrating the proposed project/initiative has an actual cultural value and that it is based upon student participation.

### **Funding for group travel**

These funds are reserved for the endorsement of educational travel to places, museums, businesses and research centers deemed valuable for the cultural and professional training of students.

Applications must be submitted by University institutions and, in order to equally distribute funding, each Department may only make a single request for aid unless there are leftover funds that can be disbursed.

Each application must include a list of participating students, who will then not be eligible for other forms of travel-related aid during the same academic year.

Applications must be submitted by March 31<sup>st</sup> of each year. Application forms, details about the rules, eligibility requirements and statement of accounts can be downloaded on the web at [www.ersusassari.it](http://www.ersusassari.it).

### **Cafeteria service**

Cafeteria service is provided in Sassari at two university run cafeterias located in Via dei Mille (accommodates 400 people) and in Via Manzella (accommodates 150). Discounted meals are available at participating restaurants in out of town locations (Nuoro, Oristano, Tempio, Alghero and Olbia)

This service is available to all students registered at the University of Sassari, the Academy of Fine Arts and the Music Conservatory.

Furthermore, university employees (faculty and non faculty), Erasmus students and students from other universities traveling here for study-related purposes may also access the cafeteria service.

In order to access this service, students must apply online and follow-up with a signed hard copy. They will then receive a magnetic ERSU card granting them access to the cafeteria service. Please note that the application entails a self-certification of academic merit and financial status which, as for all other requests for aid, is subject to investigation by the Agency. ## **Additional Services**

For the past few years, Ersu has encouraged learners to experience the lifestyle of university students by providing facilities and opportunities for socialization and by organizing events sponsored by student-run groups.

### **Book and periodical distribution services**

Starting in the 2008/2009 academic year, Sassari's Ersu has partnered with the University of Sassari's Economics, Institutions and Society Department in an effort to purchase and loan out books to inmates interested in obtaining academic degrees. Inmates at Sassari's *Casa Circondariale* and Alghero's *Casa di Reclusione* have already benefited from this initiative.

Major national and regional newspapers and magazines should soon become available to students in all residence hall lobbies. There are plans to expand this service by opening a reading room at the Via Coppino student residence.

### **Cultural Activities**

In addition to providing funding for cultural activities sponsored by student groups and organizations, Ersu organizes and supports its own cultural events.

Recent examples of such initiatives include the "Primavera in Arte" competition (May 2008), a fine arts competition open to University, Fine Arts Academy, Conservatory and high school students. The competition called for works of art (poetry, prose, short films, sculptures, photography and paintings) to be judged by a panel of experts in order to determine a winner in each category. All submitted works were displayed in the Via Coppino student residence hall and the winner of each category was entered into the national competition organized by Andisu in Perugia during the European Forum for the Right to Education (June 2008).

Participation in the competition was free and winners received a prize in money.

Considering the success of the competition's first edition, which counted about 100 participants, the Agency is planning on organizing similar initiatives in the future.

During the same academic year, Ersu organized a film festival titled "The screens of memory" (*Gli schermi della memoria*) in collaboration with the Department of Liberal Arts and the Chair of film studies. The theme of the festival was post World War II Italian films; about 300 students attended each night.

Beginning in 2006, in collaboration with Cedac and the University of Sassari, Ersu has also facilitated student meetings with stage actors and other artists. Thanks to this initiative, students have had the opportunity to meet nationally and internationally renowned figures such as Lella Costa and Luciano Ligabue.

### **Housing for foreign students and faculty**

Ersu provides a certain number of beds in its housing facilities for Erasmus students which are assigned each year concurrently with other housing and scholarship selection processes. Accommodations are assigned to students based on applications submitted by the University of Sassari's Office for Research and International Relations.

Starting in the 2008/2009 academic year, thanks to an agreement with the University of Sassari, housing for visiting professors has also become available. The aim of this service is to favor international mobility for both students and faculty through exchange programs with foreign academic institutions.

### **Discounts on drama, opera and film events**

Ersu supports students' participation in the city's cultural life by providing discounts on the city's season of drama, opera and film events.

### **Meeting facilities available for students and organizations**

Ersu makes meeting spaces available to student groups and organizations in its housing facilities for cultural and leisure activities.

Two conference rooms are currently available (at the Via Manzella and Via Coppino student residence halls).

The Via Verona conference hall is also home to the "Franco Dalerci" Center for Film Studies. As of 2009, a second conference hall with a 200 person capacity will also be available at the Via Coppino student residence.

Furthermore, in an effort to encourage students to gather in the residence halls both to study together and for leisure activities, Ersu has provided an art room

(Via Verona student residence), a computer network hall and a reading room (Via Verona student residence) and is planning the upcoming inauguration of a new “Alessio Fontana di Via Coppino” reading room as well.

### **Medical Assistance Services**

The Via Manzella student housing facility is equipped with a medical clinic for students. This service is free and is available to students from out of town who are registered at the University of Sassari. The clinic provides general medicine consultations. Since this service is connected with the university’s specialty medical departments, students can be directed to the appropriate university specialist practitioners for further consultation when needed.

Moreover, students can go to the clinic to undergo checkups in order to obtain a certificate of their fitness to participate in non-professional sports.

Services at the medical clinic are made possible by partnership with the university. Visiting hours are Monday through Friday from 4 to 6 pm. For further information, call 079/258261.

### **Internet service**

In an effort to support internet services, ERSU provides internet access points at its offices and in student housing facilities.

Moreover, wireless internet access is available in all student residences.
